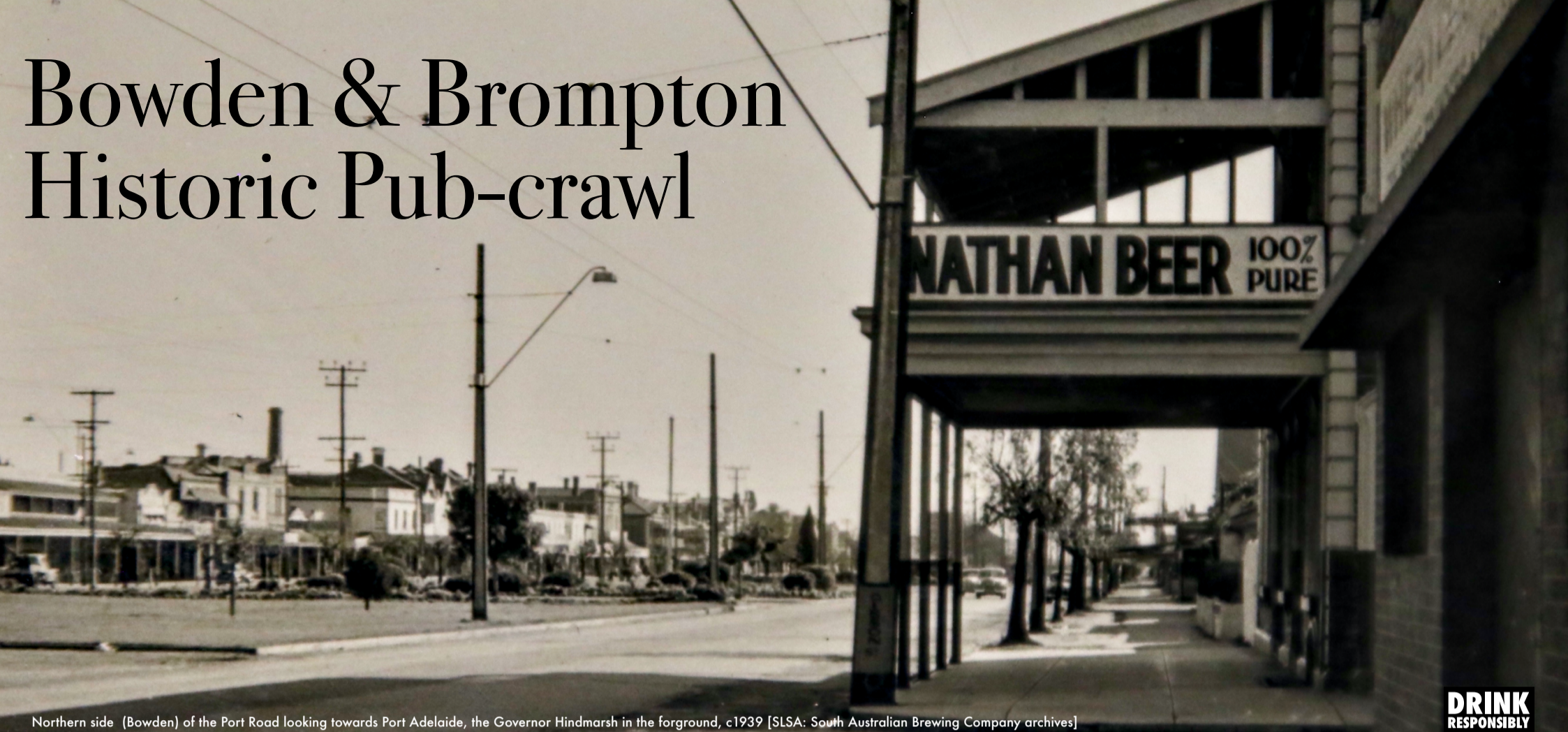

- 5 Brompton Park (1881-)
- 6 Brickmaker's Arms, Gaslight, Gasworks (1851-)
- 7 Excelsior (1884-)
